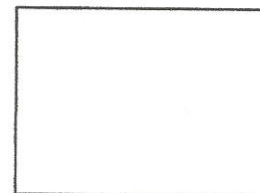

The Stewardship Ministry Team and the Consistory after consulting Conference Minister Alan Miller has decided to take this step to help us emerge from our continuing financial down turn.

The campaign will continue for the next several months. Each communion Sunday the sermon will relate to our situation and the goals we hope will bring us on more solid ground. In addition to the sermon, a testimonial from a congregational member each communion Sunday will help us to see just how important Trinity is in the life of our members and this community. Our hopes for this campaign are that we will be able to determine more accurately an "estimated" revenue which we can expect in order to pay our bills and support our missions. Yes, this means that we will be sending out the dreaded PLEDGE card. Now, before you swear an oath before God Almighty that you will NEVER fill out a pledge card because it's no one business but yours and God's, I want you to consider this. How do you decide what you can spend monthly? Do you add up your expenses and never consider what your income is for the month? Well, that is exactly what your Consistory has to do every year. You empower them to use your money for the benefit of the church and the community but don't give them any idea what that might be. How can they honestly do an efficient job if they have no idea what money is coming in until it actually arrives.

The **Annual Meeting** of the Penn Northeast Conference was held in Northampton on May 3, 2014; Pastor Steve and Dawn gave an excellent presentation highlighting the changes our church has embraced. Pastor Steve, Dawn, Jim and Janet, and Ellen and John represented Trinity.

Your Consistory continues to review and act upon recommendations brought by the Ministry Teams. Recent changes include Altar Guild preparing Communion, Worship Assistants' Schedule update including emergency replacement contact info, Operation Christmas Child will be replaced by a community-based Christmas gift project, and creation of an annual calendar of Stewardship and Hospitality Events at an all-team meeting.

Our steeple lights were repaired and bulbs replaced with energy-efficient, long-lasting LED bulbs using Memorial Fund donations. With the help of Janice Geider and Patricia Haney, we received a PPL Rebate of \$317.40! Thank you!

## **TRINITY UCC'S MINISTRY TEAM DESCRIPTIONS**

The teams promote a sense of empowerment for the operation of the church and the concept of the priesthood of every believer. The teams make recommendations to the Consistory and the Consistory approves, denies or requests additional information, research or time before making a final decision. The work of the church should be accomplished at the Team level with Consistory simply providing oversight. The following is a brief description of the areas of responsibility for the Ministry Teams:

### **Stewardship Ministry Team:** Contact Lisa Griffith

This team deals with all aspects of what it takes to operationally run the church. From fundraising to property maintenance, personnel to budget and finance, this team takes seriously God's call to lead with compassion, wisdom and discipleship. This team replaced the Finance and Budget, Property, Stewardship, Gifts and Memorials, fundraising and Constitution and Bylaws committees.

### **Hospitality Ministry Team:** Contact LuAnn Donovan

This team handles all outreach within and outside of the church. The responsibility of this team is to cultivate and nurture the relationships that the church has established in the past as well as establish new relationships for future needs of the community and the church. This team replaced the former Kitchen crew, visitation team and decorations committees while maintaining contact with the Girl Scouts, all ecumenical outreach, the Food Bank, Community Days, and the God is Still Speaking initiative through the national church.

### **Worship Ministry Team:** Contact Pastor Steve

This team handles all aspects of worship. Their responsibilities include the Altar, Communion, acolytes, greeters and ushers, Lay readers and lay pastors, supply pastors, organist/pianist, choir and nursery. They also deal with the times of service, special services including alternative services, liturgy, sound, recording, and projection systems and sanctuary layout.

### **Christian Education Ministry Team:** Contact Barb Maursky

This team implements all Sunday School, Confirmation, and Youth Group curriculums and provides the necessary resources to conduct all aspects of classes and activities. Cultivation of community seminars and workshops, Bible studies, discipleship classes, ONA education, Communion education and new member education are some of the areas of responsibility. This team, for all intent and purpose, handles all aspects of the educational needs of our congregation and community outreach.
