As we move into the new church year, thoughts have turned to Altar Flower sponsorship. In the narthex, by the entrance door, are posted a large "Flower Chart" and a large "Bulletin Chart". You are invited to sponsor flowers or bulletins in celebration of life events, or to memorialize loved ones. Cut flower bouquets provided by Garden of Eden Florists can be purchased at a cost of \$35, the sponsor receives the bouquets after the worship service. In lieu of cut flowers, artificial flowers can be placed on the altar at a donation of \$25 to Trinity UCC. Bulletin sponsorship is a \$5 donation/date. Simply write your name, sponsorship reason, and "F" for flowers or "D" for donation next to the date of your choice, on the large "Flower Chart". The procedure is the same for the "Bulletin Chart". Your donation will be announced on the projection screens scrolling announcements before and after church. On the chosen Sunday drop a separate envelope in the offering plate with the appropriate sponsorship amount and your name.

2013 Financial Report: Current Income needed each week according to the 2013 budget is approximately \$1,355.12. To date, we should have received approximately \$55,559.92 according to the budget. On 10/13/13 we received \$1,027.50. To date, our total income is \$41,899.00. We have a current budget deficit of -\$13,660.92. TRINITY UCC'S MINISTRY TEAM DESCRIPTIONS

The Ministry Team structure replaces the old committee system. The teams promote a sense of empowerment for the operation of the church and the concept of the priesthood of every believer. The teams make recommendations to the Consistory and the Consistory either approves, denies or requests additional information, research or time before making a final decision. The work of the church should be accomplished at the Team level with Consistory simply providing oversight. The following is a brief description of the areas of responsibility for the Ministry Teams:

Stewardship Ministry Team:

This team deals with all aspects of what it takes to operationally run the church. From fundraising to property maintenance, personnel to budget and finance this team takes seriously God's call to lead with compassion, wisdom and discipleship. This team replaced the Finance and Budget, Property, Stewardship, Gifts and Memorials, fundraising and Constitution and Bylaws committees.

Hospitality Ministry Team:

This team handles all outreach within and outside of the church. The responsibility of this team is to cultivate and nurture the relationships that the church has established in the past as well as establish new relationships for future needs of the community and the church. This team replaced the former Kitchen crew, visitation team and decorations committees while maintaining contact with the Girl Scouts, all ecumenical outreach, the Food Bank, Community Days, and the God is Still Speaking initiative through the national church.

Worship Ministry Team:

This team handles all aspects of worship. Their responsibility include the Altar, Communion, acolytes, greeters and ushers, Lay readers and lay pastors, supply pastors, organist/pianist, choir and nursery. They also deal with the times of service, special services including alternative services, liturgy, sound, recording, and projection systems and sanctuary layout.

Christian Education Ministry Team:

This team implements all Sunday School, Confirmation, and Youth Group curriculums and provides the necessary resources to conduct all aspects of the classes and activities. Cultivation of Community seminars and workshops, Bible studies, discipleship classes, ONA education, communion education and new member education are some of the areas of responsibility. This team for all intent and purpose handles all aspects of the educational needs of our congregation and community outreach.

- 6. Another opportunity for community hospitality occurred when Trinity was able to lend tables to the Coplay Fire Company for use in its Yard Sale September 21!


