PASTOR'S TWO CENTS:

We had a lot of activity over the summer and even more planned for the Fall. Soon, we will be at the Church picnic and the Blessing of the Pets. Then there is the new Saturday service and the continuation of the Thursday service, the PNEC Annual meeting and the Coplay Halloween Parade, annual ecumenical Thanksgiving Service follows with Advent right around the corner and all of the Christmas and New Year activities. The Ministry Teams are gearing up for an explosively exciting year. The spirituality and spiritual maturity of some of our members is phenomenal. The church seems to be overflowing with excitement and new ideas.

Yet, all of this planning and hard work hasn't gotten us out of our financial crisis. On August 4th I shared with the congregation that was present at the service that 86% of our members give less than \$250 dollars a year to keep the church afloat. This amount equates to ½% of the average income of Coplay residents. Currently, we are \$17,000 in the hole according to our budget. Obviously, ½% of income is not going to keep Trinity running much longer. The national average of donations to the church is 2 ½% of average income. An increase of 1% by all our members would literally erase our debt and allow us to pay our annual operational bills without touching our fundraising revenues.

Discipleship is the key to our financial crisis, our growth and our desire to be a missional church. We, at Trinity, are reliant on worship attendance to bring in the appropriate revenues to keep the church operating. When members don't attend worship the revenues decline. Our fundraising efforts can no longer make up the difference. Your attendance and your support of the ministries of Trinity is vital to its survival.

All the program planning and out of the box thinking has made a difference in the lives of those who attend services and participate in the life of the church. We hope that those of you who have not attended on a regular basis might decide to join us on the first Saturday of the month starting in October or on a 2nd, 3rd or 4th Thursday night of the month if Sundays aren't convenient to you. We are trying to be responsive to the needs of the congregation and in return we hope our efforts don't go unrewarded.

Please help keep Trinity open and operating by attending one of our services and participate in the life of the church and watch your life be blessed.
